
The pie chart shows that in the 1st quarter of 1902 the income was 6.1% and in the 4th quarter the income was 3.6%. The 6.1% is a reflection of refund of income tax return. The fees=dues. In the 4th quarter there was a rise of .3% from the 1st quarter to .7% in the 4th quarter. This .3% rise is due to cadre paying their capital fees on time.
