



Where do

come from?




You, the workers, add \$1 to the value of a product thru your labor. But you only get paid 25¢. The owner, the capitalist, takes the other 75¢.



So now the capitalist has \$1 worth of products to sell, but you only have 25¢ to buy it with.



The capitalist uses part of his 75¢ to expand his business so as to make even more products. After a while he has many more products than he can sell.




So the capitalist shuts down his business and throws the workers on the unemployment lines. Then, of course, you have even less money to buy products.




This creates a vicious circle. More companies shut down, more workers unemployed—and we have a depression. They are built in to this system.

How the capitalists try to solve their crisis:

1. INFLATION



Since the problem is people not having enough money to buy their products – the capitalists, who control the government, **print more money**. But this makes prices higher, so it makes the problem worse.



War is always the final solution to capitalist crisis, like in the 30's. In war time they can get the factories rolling to produce goods that are purely for destruction ---- and they put the unemployed workers in the army so they can kill each other.

The workers solution to depression:
OVERTHROW THE CAPITALISTS

Workers must take control of the economic, cultural, and political life of the nation away from the capitalists. Workers can organize the enormous productive capacity they have created so that everyone's basic needs are met and no one is unemployed.
